Pi Chi Omega Scholarship Criteria 2017-2018 Awarding Year

Recognizing the need for college educated professionals in the field of urban and industrial pest management, PI CHI OMEGA is making available 3 \$2,000 and 1 \$3,000.00 scholarship awards to students majoring in urban and industrial pest management or some closely related plan of study. The object is to encourage and assist outstanding students to prepare for careers in pest management.

Eligibility:

1. Currently enrolled undergraduate or graduate college students who are interested in urban or industrial pest management.
2. Applicants must be full time students.

Basis of Award:

1. Students who have an interest in urban or industrial pest management or some closely related field, and plan to pursue a career in such a field.
2. Must be a full time student in good academic standing. (3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale)
3. Character, personality, school activities, professional activities.
4. The scholarship may be renewed. The student will be required to resubmit the application packet.

Application Process: Items must be completed and submitted in one application packet (e-mail is preferred – office@pichiomega.org)

1. Application form
2. Resume or curriculum vita
3. Transcript (unofficial is fine) from the school currently attending
4. A one page, essay describing how your studies, research, and/or work experience will contribute to the urban and industrial pest management industry.
5. Two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from your faculty advisor and *include the advisor recommendation form*. The letters should address the applicant's progress in studies and/or research, work ethic, and contributions to the pest management industry.
6. One letter of support from a Pi Chi Omega member. A member list is available from the Executive Director, via e-mail at office@pichiomega.org. We will be happy to match you with a Pi Chi Omega Member! This maybe one of the people writing a recommendation letter.

Provisions of the Award: Scholarship recipient will receive a letter of agreement outlining these provisions that must be signed and returned prior to distribution of the scholarship award.

1. The recipient is required to write an article for the Pi Chi Omega Spring 2018 newsletter outlining their academic and/or research activities over the year and how the scholarship has helped them in their endeavors. The article will be due to the Executive Director no later than February 1st, 2018.
2. The recipient is required to remain in good academic standing, 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale. A copy of the recipient's transcript will be required at the same time as the article.

Deadline:
